Greene Township's monthly Board of Supervisors meetings are held on the second Tuesday of each month at 7:00 pm, with the exception of the January Reorganization meeting which is mandated to be held on the first Monday of the year. Workshops are held the last Tuesday every month. All meetings are open to the public and are held at the township municipal building, 262 Pittsburgh Grade Rd., Hookstown, PA 15050.

There are several opportunities for the public to speak and ask questions.

FIRST TUESDAY EACH MONTH—7:00 pm—BOS MEETING

At the regular BOS meeting, after it has been opened and the Pledge of Allegiance has been said, the Board receives public comment on the agenda items.

After all official township meeting business has been completed, residents may address the Board with their comments and/or concerns under the agenda item for Visitors.

If you wish to speak on a topic that may elicit a decision or a vote, you must request to be added to the agenda 48 hours prior to the meeting. Board approval is needed for anyone wishing to be placed on the agenda.

LAST TUESDAY OF EACH MONTH $-7:00 \ \mathrm{pm} - \mathrm{BOS}$ WORKSHOP

Workshops are held to discuss matters and provide updates in between the regular BOS meetings. Topics for discussion are prepared in advance but no official vote or decision making is done at this meeting.

INCOMING AMBULANCE SERVICE

The Hookstown Volunteer Fire Department provides emergency medical response (also known as "QRS") in addition to fire & rescue incident response in Greene Township, Hookstown, Georgetown, and currently in Hanover Township. Some of our personnel are

dually-trained as Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs) who can provide immediate basic life-saving interventions while waiting for professional full-time Emergency Medical Service (EMS) responders to arrive. In Greene Township and the surrounding areas, Medic Rescue has been the primary responding service.

From the time the 911 center notifies us that there is an emergency, HVFD personnel have been able to arrive at an incident in an average of 15.5 minutes. We are currently facing an average of 31.4 minutes for the arrival of an ambulance crew.

Recently, Greene Township passed a resolution and reached agreements with ResQRS (pronounced "Rescuers") to become a co-primary responder, along with Medic Rescue, to provide Emergency Medical Services in our community. ResQRS plans to staff overnight hours and have a unit available locally, with



hopes to provide contingencies during the day and eventually provide coverage full-time, 24x7.

According to the Journal of the American Heart
Association, a patient's outcome can be heavily impacted
by the arrival time of advanced medical interventions. I
see this collaboration as positive progress toward solving
a major issue, a crisis even, in our community.

I appreciate the partnership and cooperation between our department, the municipalities, and this agency to take steps to combat the lengthy and potentially dangerous response times we've experienced.

CAIN ROAD—HILL ROAD SOLAR PROJECT



The BE Pine Solar project is one of the largest ground mount utility grade solar projects currently under construction in Pennsylvania. When completed, the project will be located on over 200 acres of property in Beaver County located in southwestern Pennsylvania. Construction commenced on the site in October 2021, and we expect construction to be completed on or about October 2023.

This Project will be interconnected to the Duquesne Light Company infrastructure and will produce approximately 60 MWh of Clean Renewable Energy during the first full year of operation. This quantity of electricity is enough to offset the annual electrical usage of approximately 6,000 homes. This project will also result in the offset or reduction of approximately 25,000 tons of carbon dioxide annually when compared to electricity generated from the combustion of fossil fuels.

Currently, the solar project is expected to remain operational and producing renewable energy for at least 40 years.
