Affidavit for exemption of the provisions of the UCC

Agricultural building – (Defined under Section 7210.103 of the PA UCC)

A structure utilized to store farm implements, hay, feed, grain or other agricultural or horticultural products or to house poultry, livestock or other farm animals, a milk house and a structure used to grow mushrooms. The term includes a carriage house owned and used by members of a recognized religious sect for the purposes of housing horses and storing buggies. The term shall not include habitable space or spaces in which agricultural products are processed, treated or packaged and shall not be construed to mean a place of occupancy by the general public.

The applicant certifies receipt of the responsibilities and requirements adopted by the Department of Labor and Industry and the local Municipality. The property owner and applicant assumes the responsibility of compliance with all the applicable regulations of the authorities having jurisdiction. Issuance of a permit shall not be construed as authority to violate, cancel or set aside any provisions of the codes or documents or ordinances of the municipality or any other governing body. The applicant certifies he/she understands all the applicable codes, ordinances and regulations. Application for any other required permits shall be made by the owner or lessee of the building or structure, or agent of either.
